



## Vintage Stores & Fashion Exhibit at Museum

- **Boulder**
  - **Candy's** – 2512 B Broadway – 303-442-6186. Hours: 11-6 Monday through Saturday. A nice assortment of vintage clothing.
  - **Gold Mine** – 1123 Pearl Street (on the Pearl St. Mall) – 303-447-0065. Hours: M-Th 11-8; Fr-Sat 11-9; Sun 11-7. A few pieces from the Ragtime era through the 20s and 30s, and then more for later years. Men's included, but that is mostly more recent. Good selection of western vintage men's shirts.
- **Denver**
  - **Boss Vintage** – 10 S. Broadway – 303-871-0373. Hours: M-S 11-6; Sun 12-5. Denver's best and largest vintage clothing shop. Men's and women's. Mostly starts at 1930s, and then goes later. Lots of hats, accessories. A nice Goodwill Store is directly across the street.
  - **Regal Vintage** – situated in Denver's Antique Row – 1866 S. Broadway – 303-830-0216. Hours: Tues-Sat 11-7; Sun 12-5. Jam packed with goodies, largely 1950s and beyond, though there are a few things earlier. Lots of hats and accessories. Also men's.
  - **Flossy McGrews** – 1824 S. Broadway – 303-778-0853. Hours: Mon-Sat 11-6; Sun 12-3. Just a few doors down from Regal. The exterior is fairly offputting – very Goth and Halloweenish. The inside is semi a mess. But there are treasures lurking within for those with some time and patience.

### Fabrics, Trims, and Millinery Supplies

- **Allyn's Bridal and Fabric Supplies** – 2306 E. 6<sup>th</sup> Ave., **Denver** – 303-377-4969. Hours: Tue-Fri 9-5; Sat 9-3. This rabbit warren of a shop is a Denver treasure! It began as a millinery supply store, and they still have all sorts of wonderful hat trims (but you can't go downstairs to search – they have to bring them up for you), amazing fabrics and trims. People come from a multi-state area to shop there. It's a treasure hunt, with a knowledgeable staff, and a place to really spend some time.
